# 2nd Annual Juried Competition

# 2010

**Description:** The Idaho Falls Arts Council announces a call to artists for our 2nd Annual Juried Competition to be exhibited in the Carr Gallery on the street level of the Willard Arts Center in historic, downtown Idaho Falls. Artists working in all mediums and all regions are invited to submit. This is an open show with no geographic boundaries. The exhibition will run from March 12 to May 1, 2010, during which time it is estimated that the Carr Galley will see over 5000 unique visitors.

**Prizes:** 3 cash prizes will be awarded: first place (\$550), second place (\$250), and third place (\$200). 2 honorable mention prizes will also be awarded.

### **Deadlines and Important Dates:**

- JPEG images delivered by January 30, 2010.
- Notification of accepted artwork goes out February 16, 2010.
- Accepted artwork to be delivered to the Idaho Falls Arts Council (498 A St.) 10 am – 4pm on Tuesday and Wednesday, March 9 and 10, 2010.
- Awards presentation and opening reception begins at 7pm on Friday, March 12.
- Pickup artwork 10am – 4pm on Monday and Tuesday, May 3 and 4, 2010.

**Submission Rules:** Entry fee is \$25 (free for current IFAC members) and provides the artist with the added benefit of becoming an Idaho Falls Arts Council member artist for one year. (For more information about artist member benefits, please follow the “membership” link on [www.idahofallsarts.org](http://www.idahofallsarts.org).)

Artists may submit up to 3 JPEG images no larger than 1M or 200dpi. 2D and 3D works are welcome. Artwork must be created within the last three years. Works previously exhibited at the Carr Gallery are not eligible. The entry form must be filled out and received along with JPEG submissions by January 30. **Accepted Artwork:** Accepted artwork notifications will be sent on February 16. Accepted works must be delivered to the Idaho Falls Arts Council offices at 498 A St. between the hours of 10am – 4pm on Tuesday and Wednesday, March 9 and 10. Work must be delivered ready to exhibit. 2D works must be framed with a secure hanging wire on the back. IFAC is not responsible for shipping costs. All return shipping needs to be arranged by the artist. Following the exhibition, artwork must be picked up between the hours of 10am – 4pm on Monday and Tuesday, May 3 and 4, 2010.

**Sales:** Artists have the option of selling their work. IFAC will take a commission of 35% on all sales. Checks will be mailed to individual artists within 30 days of the exhibition closing.
