The Idaho Falls Arts Council (IFAC) is searching for a dynamic and experienced individual who is committed to fostering our mission to educate our community and enrich its quality of life by promoting, advocating and presenting a broad spectrum of visual and performing arts in eastern Idaho. We support our mission with the Colonial Theater, Carr Gallery and Hall Community Gallery, the WAC Artist Studios, and ARTitorium on Broadway, an interactive art center for kids.

The ARTitorium Theater Teacher will be responsible for planning and implementing a series of theater classes for kids/youth in the MC Theater at ARTitorium on Broadway. Duties include developing and teaching curriculum for weekly theater classes during the school year and week-long camps during the summer. Classes are for children at least ages 5-12 (and possibly older), split into smaller age groups as desired. ARTitorium currently offers 4-week visual arts classes every month of the school year and would like the theater classes to echo this model. Additionally, the Theater Teacher will coordinate all set-up and break-down for the classes, assist with student check-in, and conduct evaluations as needed. There are opportunities for classes to culminate in a public production at the MC Theater and/or Colonial Theater if this is deemed appropriate.

The ARTitorium Theater Teacher reports to the Visual Arts Director.
