The Battle of the Bands is a chance for regional youth bands to show off their skills and compete for prizes. All members of entering bands must be 21 or younger. Each band will perform for 12-15 minutes with a professional crew and sound and light systems.

This year's prizes include over \$3,000 worth of gear packages and gift certificates from No Limit Guitar Co.

The event will be free to the public.
