The Idaho Falls Arts Council is pleased to present the Aquila Theatre's production of *Sense and Sensibility* on March 16th at 7:30pm.

Sense and Sensibility is Jane Austen's classic tale of the Dashwood sisters as they face a change in their station. As their family weathers this change, the sisters face seduction, courtship, love, heartbreak, and surprises at the hands of the shy Edward Ferras, the steadfast Colonel Brandon, and the dashing John Willoughby.

Aquila Theatre is a small repertory theater with a talent for adapting classic literature for the stage. They have previously performed *The Adventures of Sherlock Holmes* and *Wuthering Heights* in Idaho Falls. Because of the small number of actors on tour, that are also performing another play, some roles cast in unique, but thoughtful ways.

In conjunction with the show, Almacks Historic Dance Society will be offering Regency era dance lessons prior to the show from 6-7pm at the Willard Arts Center. Dates are not required and registration is \$7.50 or \$5 for members of IFAC or Almacks.
