The Idaho Falls Arts Council is pleased to present two returning favorite gallery exhibitions—The Idaho Watercolor Society and Samantha Gresham. Both exhibitions will have opening receptions during September Gallery Walk on September 6th from 5-8 pm at the Willard Arts Center.

The Idaho Watercolor Society is an annual favorite in the Carr Gallery. This year the exhibition theme is Color! + Black, demonstrating the challenge of painting with black. During the month of September, the statewide Annual Show prize winners will be on display. Beginning in October, works by local featured artist Kerri Lindstrom will be on display with the exhibition.

Samantha Gresham is a local artist who began displaying at the Willard Arts Center at age 14 in the Annual Juried Exhibition. This will be her second solo show at the Willard Arts Center in the Hall Gallery.

“We love having local and regional artists on display in the Willard Arts Center, and these two are always popular and eye-catching,” said Georgina Goodlander, Visual Arts Director for the Idaho Falls Arts Council, “It has been fun to watch styles evolve and new techniques tried each time they return.”
