Exhibition Opening: Daniel Borup

Daniel Borup's solo exhibition in the Carr Gallery opens November 5 and will run until January 10th. The Idaho Falls Arts Council will be hosting an opening reception on Friday, November 6th from 5:30 – 7:30 pm, with the artist and live music.

Daniel Borup is a sculptor from Shelley, Idaho. His work is inspired by the human figure and combines both abstract and classical elements to create pieces that are both contemporary and timeless.

"I strive to make my work come to life. I want my figures to look as if they feel emotions and could walk right off their pedestal. I have spent years studying anatomy and sculpture so I can more accurately render the human figure in all of its many gestures and expressions," said Daniel Borup in an excerpt from his artist's statement.

"This is the first sculpture show we've had in a couple of years," said Georgina Goodlander, Visual Arts Director of the Idaho Falls Arts Council, "Daniel does so much for the arts in our community, particularly with the youth; we couldn't be more excited to return the favor and have his incredible works on display in a solo show."
