Idaho Falls Arts Council presents: Hear My Voice

Idaho Falls, ID, January 18, 2016:

The Idaho Falls Arts Council is pleased to present Hear My Voice in the Carr Gallery on January 29th at 7:30 pm with discussion facilitated by Jim Francis.

Hear My Voice tells the story of Jesse, a young girl in early 1900s Washington DC as she learns about the women's suffrage movement and, despite her parents' objections, take it upon herself to help make a difference.

Jim Francis is a former history teacher at Idaho Falls High School, an Adjunct Instructor in the History Department at Idaho State University, and was named Idaho Humanities Council Teacher of the Year 2011.

Hear My Voice is a continuation of the Living Voices Series that took place at the MC Theater last year. These presentation feature a single actor and a multi-media presentation, and focus on composite characters in significant periods of history based on real accounts.

"The Living Voices presentations foster such great discussion, about history and about how these themes and struggles still affect us," said Brandi Newton, Executive Director of the Idaho Falls Arts Council, "By moving them to round tables in the gallery and having incredible educators like Jim participate, we hope to continue to raise the level of discussion."
