*The New American* is a presentation of the Living Voices series that follows Bridget, a young immigrant in the early 1900s who comes to America in hopes of supporting her family back in Ireland. Once she has made it through the harsh conditions of her journey and Ellis Island, she is faced with further struggles in New York as she works for the infamous Triangle Shirtwaist Factory.

Living Voices presentations are single actor multi-media presentations that use composite characters to focus on historical events and eras. The presentation will be followed by a discussion lead by Dr. David Adler and actress Rachel McClinton.
