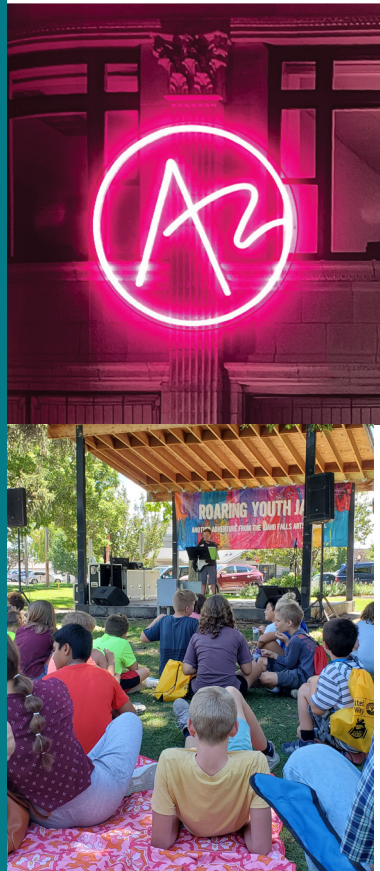

The Idaho Falls Arts Council has been busier than ever during the 2022-2023 season!

We presented eight nationally touring shows as part of our mainstage season, including Kathy Mattea and Suzy Bogguss, The Magic of Rob Lake, One Night of Queen, and Skerryvore. Additionally, we presented three special engagements and four intimate performances in our A Street Sessions series. Ryan Hamilton sold out one of his performances at the Colonial in November, and Jig Jam sold out their A Street Session in March. Several shows including matinee performances for local students, including six almost-full matinee performances for Jig Jam alone!

We hosted eight visual art exhibitions in our two galleries. Highlights included solo shows from up and coming artists such as Colter May and Kristol Coker, group shows from established organizations like Gallery 12 and the Colored Pencil Society, and a new group of contemporary Idaho artists exhibiting under the headline "Elemental." The 15th Annual National Juried Exhibition received entries from the most number of states ever with 386 entries from 27 states.

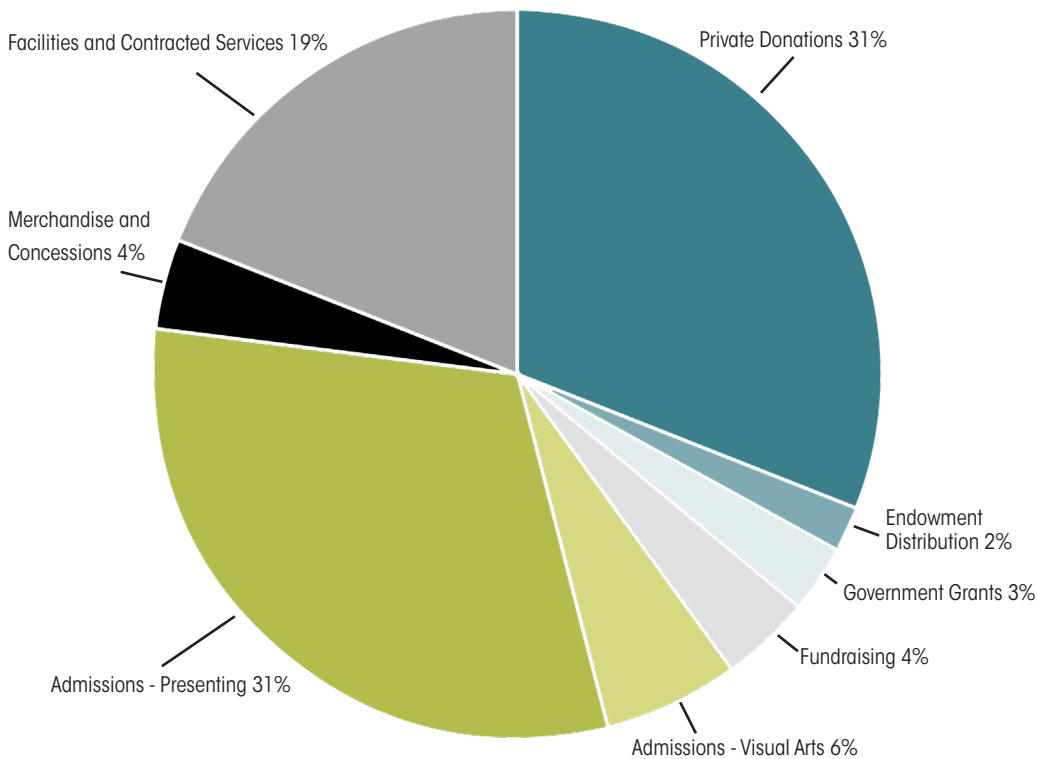


We rebranded the Idaho Falls Gallery Walk, which takes place on first Thursdays every May through October, to be the Idaho Falls Art Walk, in order to allow a broader interpretation of the type of art that could be included in the event. River Concerts and Planet Arts continued over the summer, and this year we added "Planet Glee" to the weekly offerings.

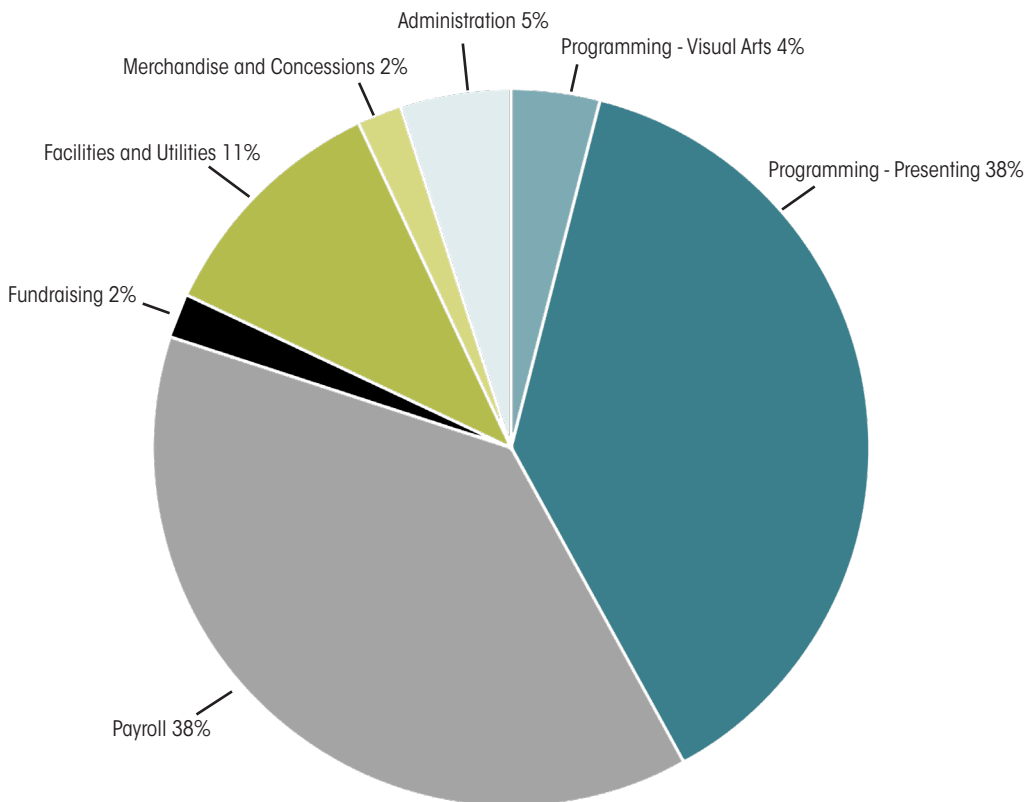
ARTitorium on Broadway continued to grow over the year, with over 12,000 regular admissions and over 7,000 students visiting on field trips. We installed two new attractions: an updated and more streamlined Green Screen experience and a brand new "Everbright," which is like a giant Lite Brite. Theater camps and classes returned to the programming at ARTitorium, and the Reader's Theater students performed at Youth Jam. The 2022 Youth Jam theme was "Fairytales and Fantasy" and we saw even more participation than ever in this popular three-day event.

We completed several significant improvements to our facilities over the year, including a major renovation of the administrative offices and back hall of the Willard Arts Center, a large mural in the Colonial Lobby by artist Alex Peterson of Pete and Pen, new handrails in the balcony of the Colonial Theater, upgraded LED lighting throughout the Willard Arts Center, and new digital marketing in the theater lobby.
